





Stainless Steel Level Wind. Penn's stainless steel, positive level wind device evenly spools line on reel for repeated, carefree fishing. Line pays out evenly when free spooling.

Stainless Steel Inner and Outer Rings. Adding structural integrity to the frame of the GTO Reels, the inner and outer rings are made from stainless steel for improved corrosion resistance.


Proven Penn Gearing. Precision machined gears create an incredibly strong gearing system built for years of service and performance.

Stainless Steel Ball Bearings. For unparalleled smoothness in casting, reeling and battling oversized gamefish, nothing beats precision stainless steel ball bearings. Penn GTO Series Reels feature, stainless steel ball bearings.

Anodized Aluminum Spool. The aluminum spool is lightweight and strong, and the anodized finish provides the ultimate in corrosion resistance for season after season of hard fishing.

Penn Handle. A counterbalanced, Soft-Grip handle found on the smaller models is comfortable for lengthy fish battles, while the larger models feature a power handle designed for cranking power. The Soft-Grip handle provides a secure grip, even when hands are wet and slimy.

Other Quality Features. Stainless steel reel stand and a molded-graphite, one-piece rod clamp combine for an extra measure of strength and security of joining reel to rod.



CARE AND LUBRICATION

Your Penn Reel is quality manufactured for maximum durability. Like any other precision-made piece of equipment, reasonable care will ensure peak performance and longevity.

After each fishing trip, the reel should be cleaned with a soap solution and fresh water, preferably warm, to remove any accumulated salt deposits.

When washing the reel, use caution not to use a driving force of water, since the water pressure will force salt deposits and/or sand into the reel. A very fine spray will help dissolve the salt on the external parts of the reel and rinse from the reel.

Dry excess moisture from the reel and then sparingly lubricate all exposed areas. A good practice is to spray a rag with a pressurized spray lubricant and wipe down the reels with the rag. Your reel should be stored in a cool, dry place. Do not store in a plastic bag, as condensation may develop.

Periodically examine your reel and tighten loose screws and fittings. Depending upon use, your reel should be overhauled at least once every season.

Frictional points in the reel should be frequently lubricated, and for best results use Penn lubricant. Penn's tubes of lube are the right formula, designed specifically for Penn Reels. Keep in mind, that a few drops of oil is usually sufficient

Major points for external lubrication include: Handle knob, eccentric lever, left and right side bearings, and clicker button.
